MAKEOVERS

Since the departure of the now completely gone Maison D'Azur, **The Angler's Boutique Resort** hasn't exactly been a major dining destination. The owners, however, hope to change that with a revamped and newly expanded **660**, featuring a new menu, lounge, and sidewalk dining. The new menu, created by chef **Giorgio Rapicavoli**, features dishes like **crispy braised pork belly** with maple, sweet potato, pecans, smoked oil, and sea salt; **olive oil poached piquillo peppers** with goat cheese; and **twelve hour braised short ribs** with porcini and truffle risotto. There's also a **new artisanal cocktail menu** and an expanded bar and lounge area inside featuring **resident DJ Amália**. [EaterWire]
